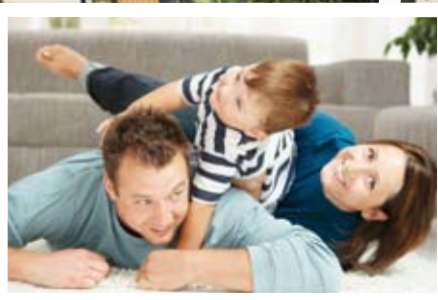

Nantwich is a medieval market town located on the banks of the River Weaver in the south of the Cheshire plain. It is a much sought after location in which to live, offering good schools and easy accessibility to the rest of the North West and further afield. It is second only to Chester in the county for its wealth of historic buildings.

Transport

Nantwich enjoys excellent public transport links, and is on the Manchester, Crewe and Shrewsbury line providing convenient travel on the trains. Nearby Crewe station provides connections for Manchester, Liverpool, Chester and North Wales while Shrewsbury station provides connections for Wolverhampton, Hereford and Aberystwyth. The M6 is easily accessible and opens up the doors to Manchester and the north towards Scotland or south to Stoke-on-Trent and Birmingham. Manchester Airport is just over 24 miles away. Nantwich town centre also has a Bus Station.

Shopping

Take a stroll through the atmospheric streets and visit bijoux boutiques, antiques dealers and contemporary craft shops as well as traditional food shops and the Market.

Schools

The town has eight primary schools (Highfields Community, Willaston Primary Academy, Millfields, Pear Tree, St Anne's (Catholic), Stapeley Broad Lane (Church of England), The Weaver and The Wyche). There are also two secondary schools, Brine Leas School and Malbank School and Sixth Form College. Reaseheath College runs further education courses in conjunction with Harper Adams University and the University of Chester.

Sport & Leisure

Nantwich Swimming Pool offers an indoor and outdoor swimming pool, fully kitted gym with a range of fitness classes whilst Barony Park Sports Complex offers full sports facilities for playing tennis, football, rugby and bowls along with a skate park. The town also has a Football Club and a Cricket Club

Days out

Whatever your interests, you'll find plenty to do in Nantwich. There are many visitor attractions within a short distance of the town, including Bridgemere Nursery and Garden World, the Secret Nuclear Bunker, Nantwich Museum and Cholmondeley Castle Gardens. It is also a major centre for canal holidays with several marinas within easy reach on the Shropshire Union and Llangollen canals. Nantwich hosts a number of festivals through the year including Nantwich Show and the International Cheese Awards, Nantwich Jazz Festival and the Food Festival.
